 Many military students, upon entering college or other postsecondary institutions, find they may need tutoring and/or additional educational support outside the classroom.



 Ole Miss is not developing tutoring programs designed specifically for student veterans, but want them to be able to take advantage of what we currently offer.



- Whether walk-in or by schedule, getting the word out to veteran students that academic resources are available to support them is an important step.
- Ole Miss is looking into offering priority registration for student veterans who sign up for weekly tutoring sessions.



 Regardless, know that you're student veterans will not be shy about asking for extra help and you should not be shy about letting them know they may need it. It's all about the delivery.



 While most institutions offer free tutoring services, students using educational benefits (including dependents) and in need of more intensive tutoring services may be eligible to receive additional assistance from the VA to defray tutoring expenses.



- Whatever you do, let student veterans know these resources exist at Ole Miss.
- Ensuring this information is getting out to the veteran community is critical, since tutoring can often be the missing link between dropping out and graduating.



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
